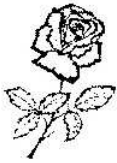
If you wish to remain on our mailing/email list, could you please complete and return the Registration of Interest form to PO Box 180, Balclutha, by 31 July 2006.

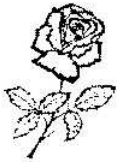

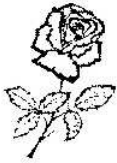
Registration and Welcome Function Friday 2 February 2007

Jubilee Function 'Big Top Night' Saturday 3 February 2007 at 7.30pm

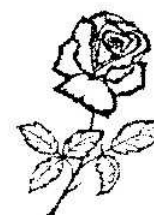
